

HEADED NORTH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Headed North Scholarship Fund believes that no child should be prevented from participating in after school activities because of financial need. Headed North Scholarship Fund supplements activity fees and uniform costs for students in grades K-12 who need financial assistance in order to participate in after-school activities. Students must live or go to school in the Shawnee Mission North attendance area to qualify.

General Information

- Headed North Fund provides monetary support for students participating in after school activities.
- Boys and girls in grades K-12 who reside or attend a school located within the boundaries of Shawnee Mission North High School who cannot pay the full cost of registration fees for after school activities may apply for limited financial assistance (scholarship).
- Assistance is based on availability of funds and financial need. Financial need is based on current free/reduced lunch guidelines as provided by the USDA.
- Scholarships may be provided with a percentage of the cost based on need but are not intended to provide the full fee. Families are expected to provide a portion of the fee. Scholarships are generally limited to no more than 75% of the activity cost.
- Scholarships are generally not granted for registration fees when the sponsoring organization offers financial assistance to its members. Additionally, scholarships are not generally provided for fees associated with premier/tournament teams or camps.
- Generally, students are limited to three scholarships per year.
- Shawnee Mission North High School students may not receive scholarship monies for school-sponsored activities due to regulations of the Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA).
- Scholarships are not transferable, refundable, and have no cash value.

Requirements

- Applicants for scholarships MUST be currently enrolled as a student at a SM North attendance area school and/or live within the boundaries of the Shawnee Mission North attendance area.
- Applications for out of boundaries persons, incomplete applications, and applications without signatures will not be considered.
- The policies of the Headed North Scholarship Fund are the same for everyone without regard to race, sex, creed, color, national origin, age, sexual orientation, or physical limitation.

Procedures

- Applications for scholarships must be received at least 30 days prior to need.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Board of Directors of the Headed North Scholarship Fund. All application information is strictly confidential.
- Applicants will be notified, in writing, of the status of their application at least 10 days prior to need.
- Fees will be paid directly to the organization. Reimbursements will not be made to recipients.
